(C2) is the landed price including CMC and all taxes and duties for the 121 sets of the other Equipment as per Annexure 12 (B)

(D) is the Total Cost for Medical Equipment including CMC and all taxes for the mentioned quantities. The Prices should be FOR Bhubaneswar. This price will be the determining price for ascertaining the L1 Bidder.
